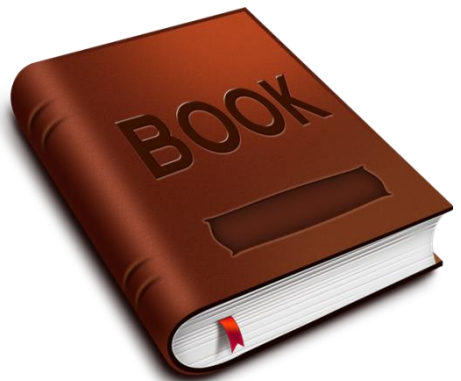
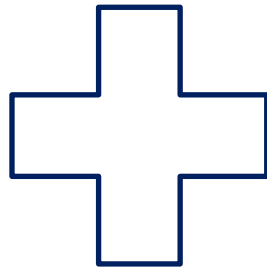
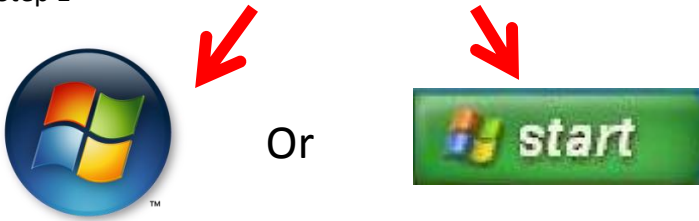


How to use Facebook

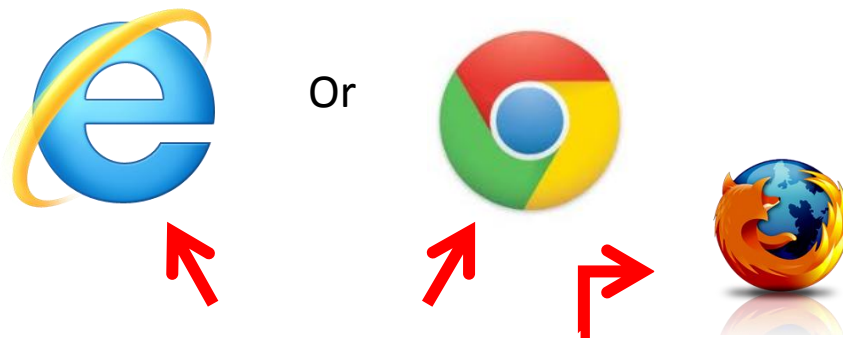


Start by clicking on the ***start button***

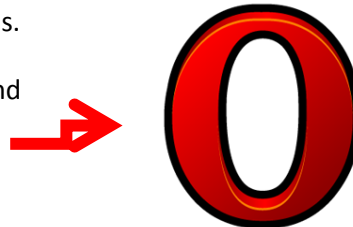

After you've clicked on the **start button** look for one of the these icons.

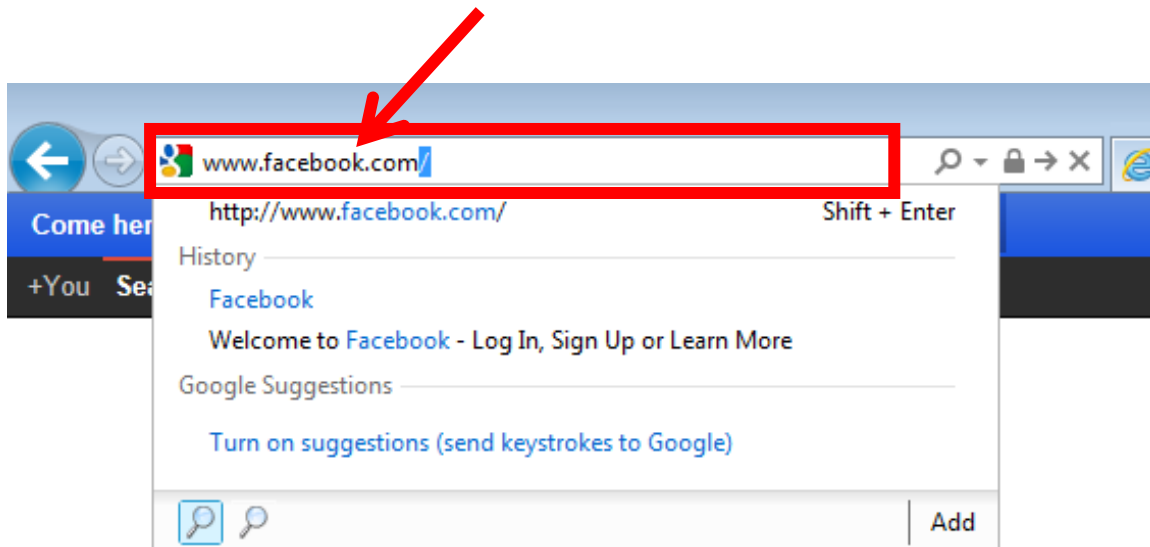
If not there, type in the search bar and type in **internet** once there, click on internet exploer

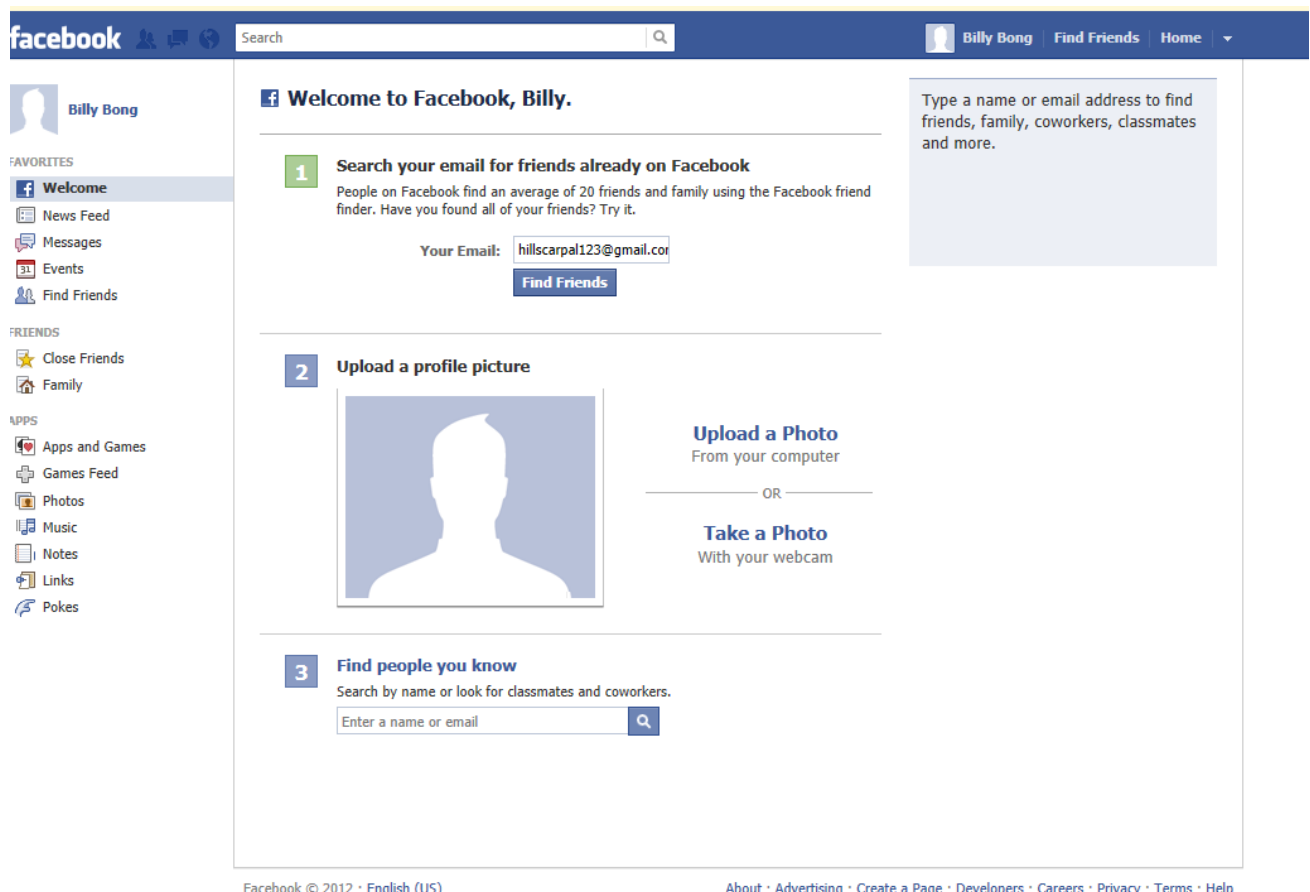

How to log in to Facebook

2. Then enter the password you used here.

Introduction to F/B Icons

When someone wants to be your friend, you can click here and accept their friend request. (Only accept if you know them very well)

When people have written on your Facebook wall you can view it by clicking here.

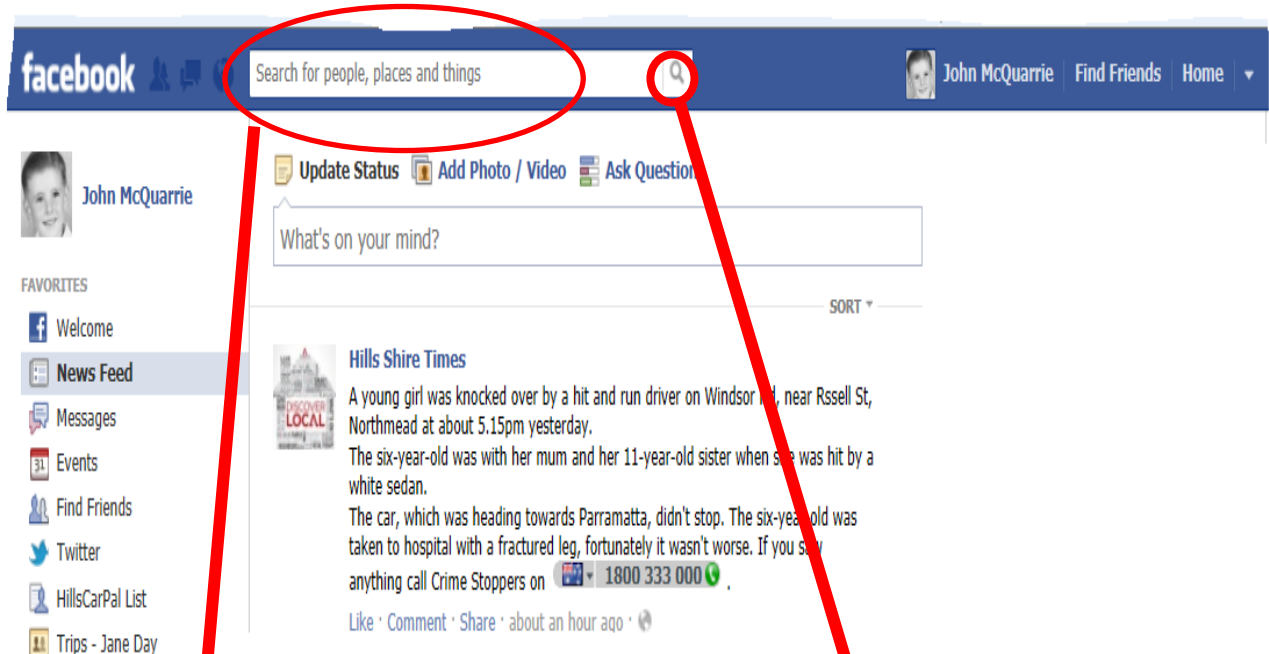
If you want to search a friends name and add them you can type their name here.



When someone sends you a message you can view it by clicking here.

If you want to let your friends know what you are doing, you can write a post and all your friends can see what you are up to

How to Add a Friend



This is where you can look up:

- a **Friend** like John McQuarrie (of Baulkham Hills),
- a **Page** like HillsCarPal or HillsCarPal Clients,
- a **Group** like the Trip Group you will be creating, or
- **Lists** like "HillsCarPal List"

by simply clicking in the box and typing in their name.

Then, if necessary, click the Magnifying Glass for search.



If this is the person you are looking for
click on the “Add Friend” button next
to his name.

NOTE: You will need to add all the
HillsCarPal Drivers and John McQuarrie
as your Friend In order to go ahead
with the procedure .



If someone adds you as a friend you will have a little red number next to the people icon telling you how many people have added you.

If someone adds you as a friend you do have the choice to accept or decline (by clicking on "Not Now"). If you decline they will not know.

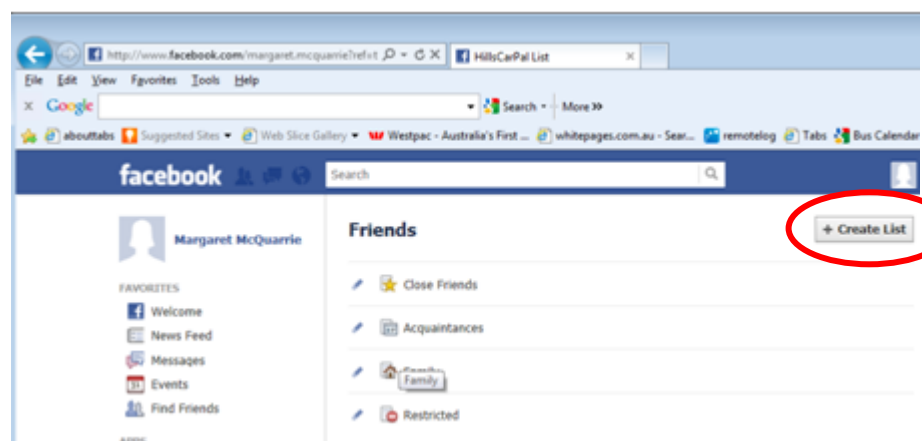
How to Create a List

1. On the Left Hand Side of YOUR Facebook page, hover over “Friends” to see “More” appear alongside it.

2. CLICK on “More”.

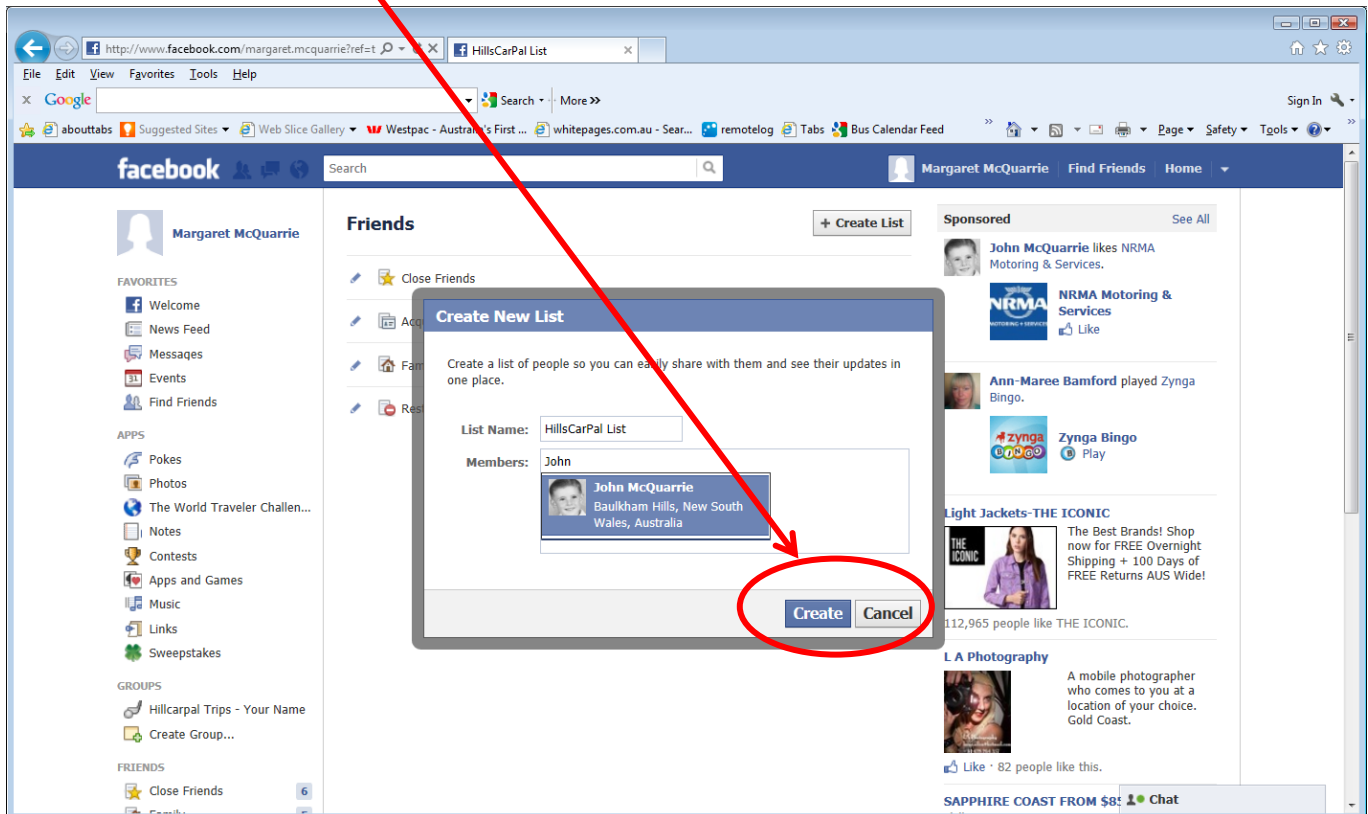


3. Click on “Create List”

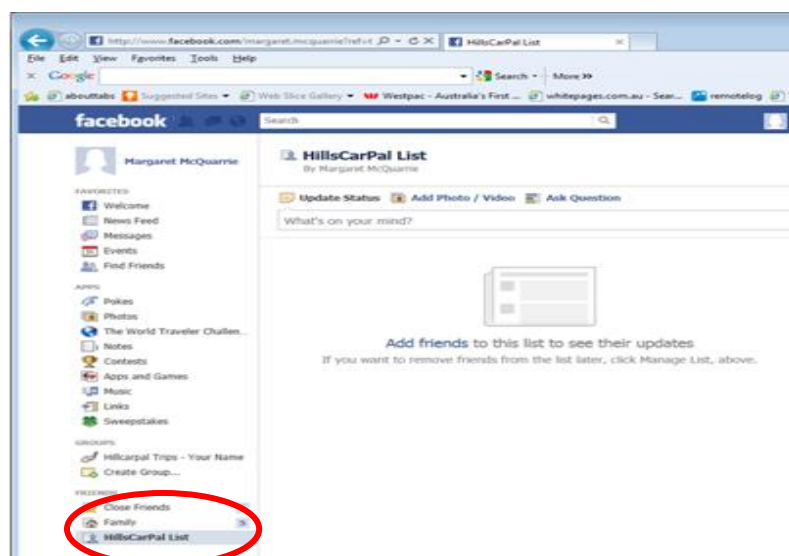


4. Type "HillsCarPal List" and enter John McQuarrie (and any HillsCarPal Drivers that you have as Friends of your facebook page) as members of the List.

5. Click on "Create"

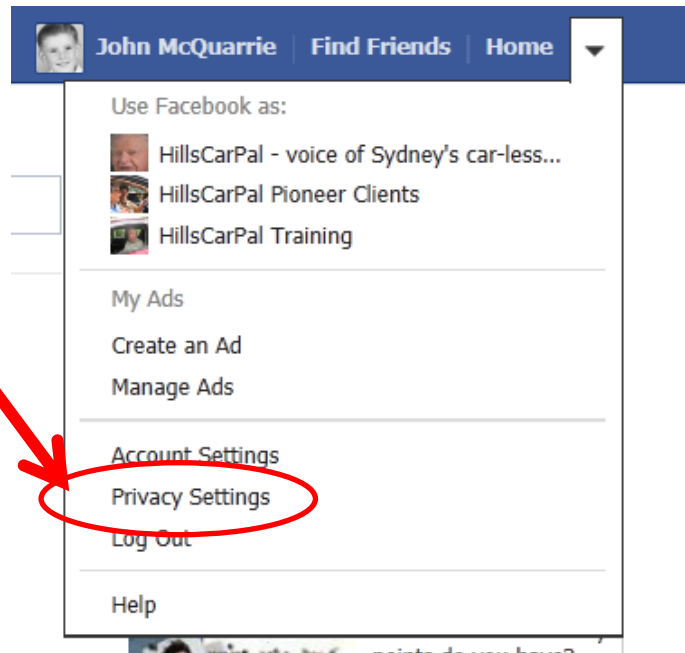

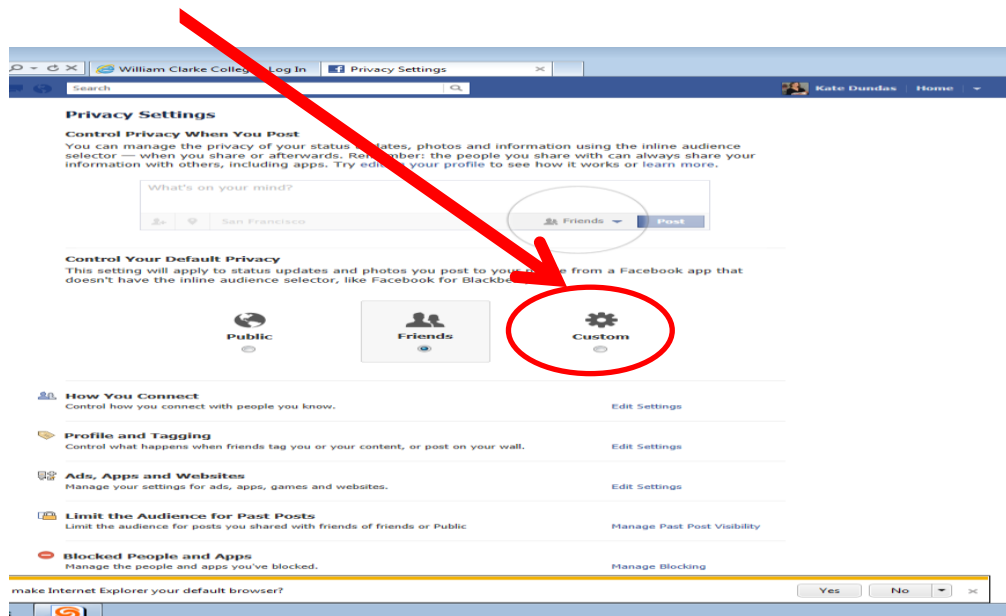
Go To Privacy Settings:

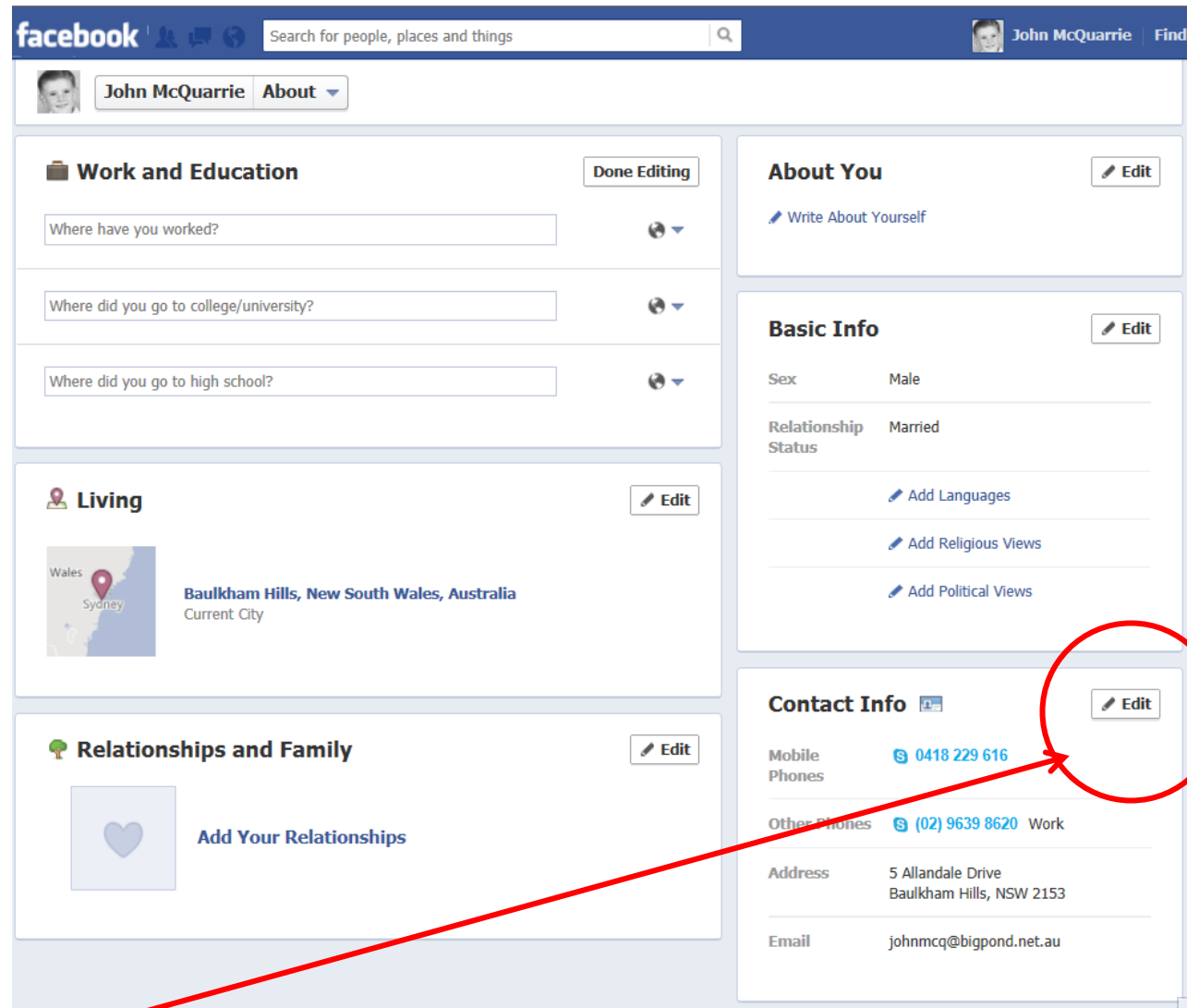

4. Type in the highlighted box **HillsCarPal List** - instead of John McQuarrie, as John should already be a member of your HillsCarPal List.

Limiting who can see your contact details:





1. Go to your Facebook Timeline Page (similar to John McQuarrie's Timeline page above)
2. Click on "Update Info"




3 Click on **Edit** in the "Contact Info" panel

- 4 Then select the drop down arrowhead next to each piece of Contact Info you have provided. Sometimes its the best to not put your 100% legit info because hackers can track you if not careful.
- 5 Then select "HillsCarPal List" for each one of the pieces of info that you have provided to Facebook.
- 6 Then click 'Save" at the bottom of the "Edit" dialogue box.

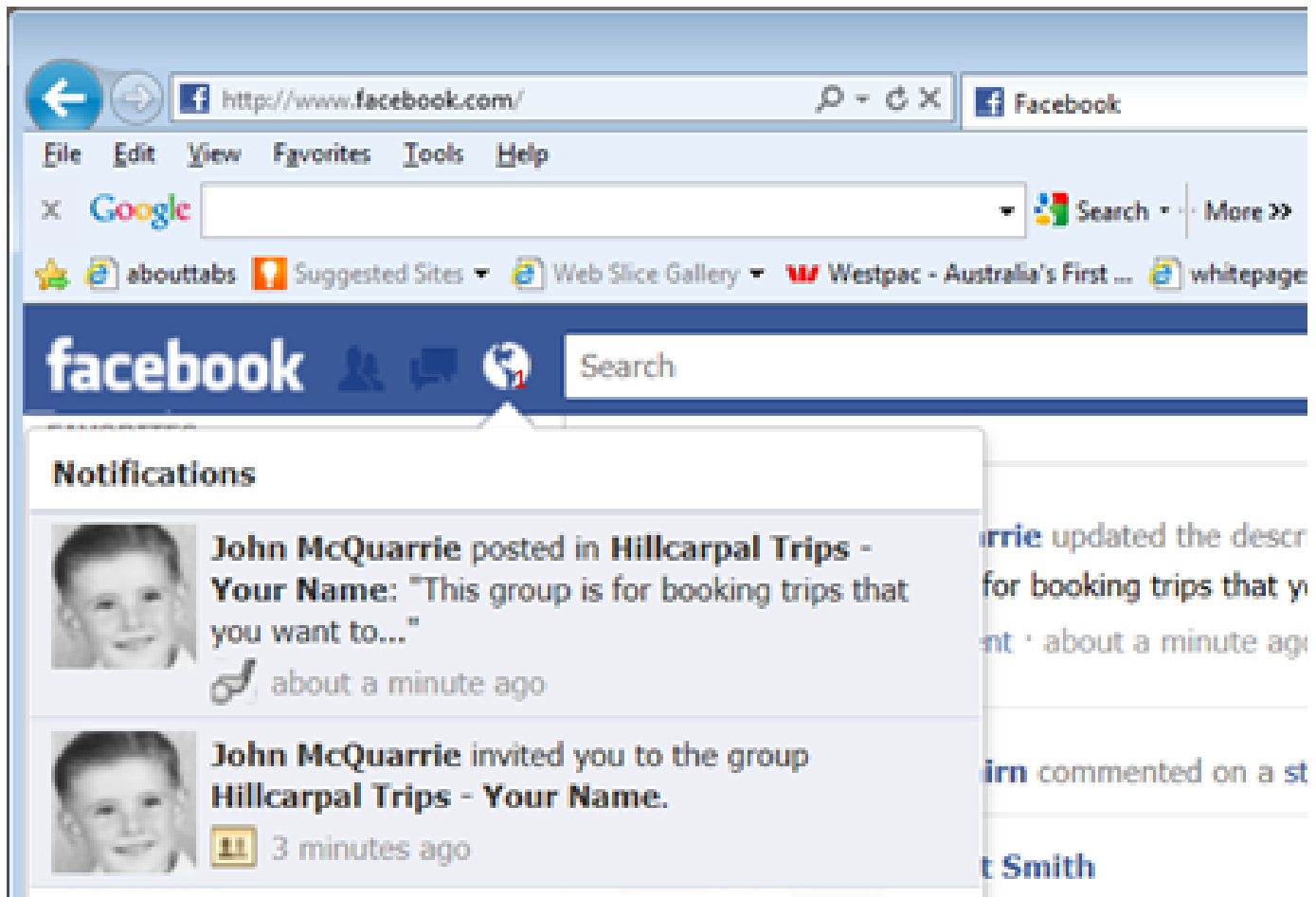

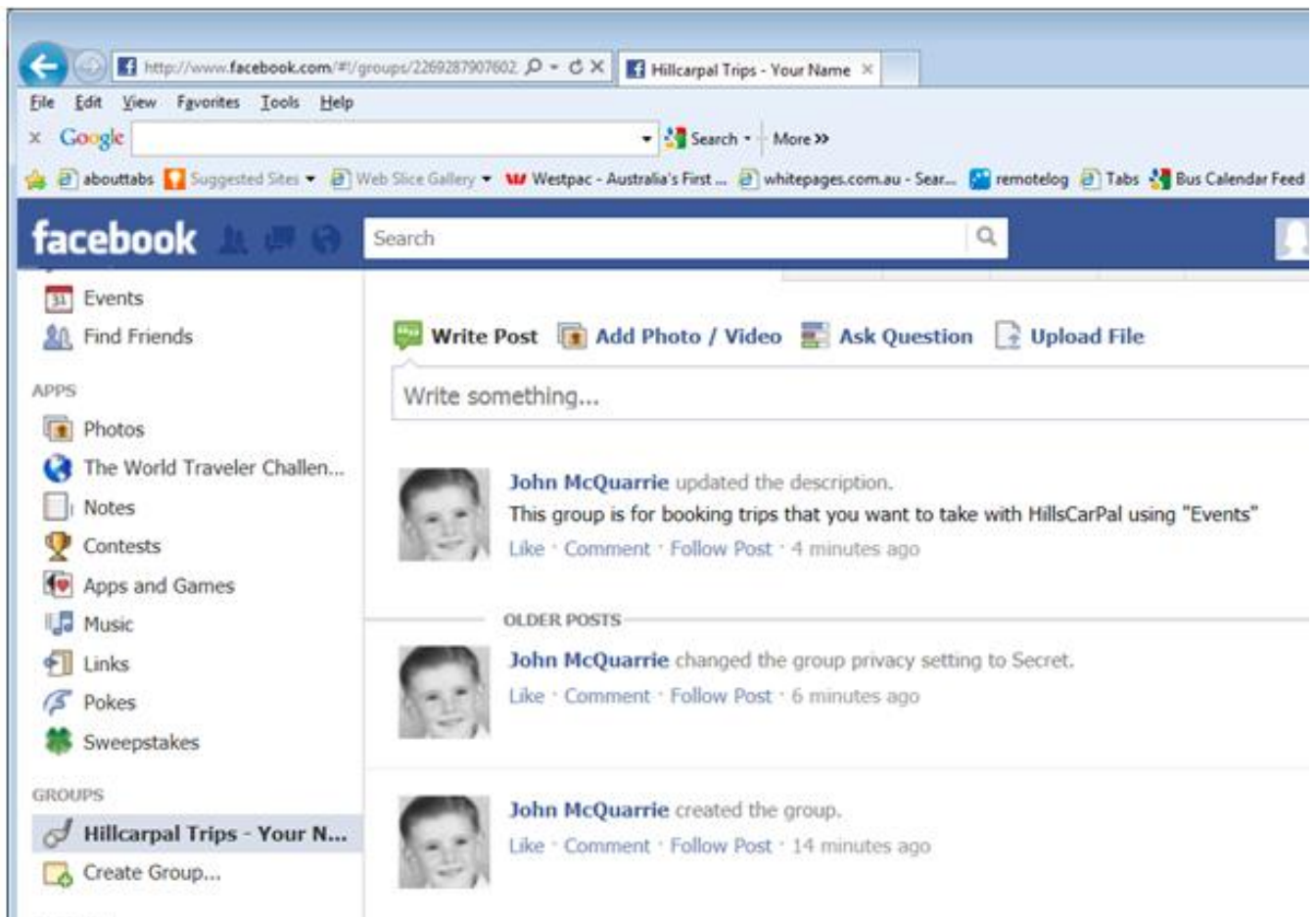

Joining a Facebook group



Steps on “How to join a group on Facebook”.

1. After logging in to Facebook with your email address and your password, look for the numeral “1” in the notifications area at the top left of your F/B page.
2. If it is there, click on the notification area and it will bring up a message telling you that John McQuarrie has invited you to (join) the group “HillsCarPal Trips – Your Name”.
3. Click on the message; and
4. You should see a page that looks like following page with a post like the one at the top of the following page – see over.



By clicking on the message in Step 3 of page 19 you accept membership of the group and the group is added to your F/B Page in the Left Hand Side column.

NOTE 1: You will also receive an email telling you that you are invited to join the Group. You don't need to do anything in response to the email if you have followed all the steps on page 19 above

NOTE 2: If "HillsCarPal Trips – Your Name" doesn't appear in the list of Groups (on your F/B Page in the Left Hand Side column) automatically, click "View" and then "Refresh" on your browser or press the F5 key.

Creating an event

1. First go to the group called (trips-clients name) but it will be your name instead of client name (make sure that you are in the group and not on the left side of the page in Facebook)



2. Then you need to create an event on Facebook. Next there will be a button in the group labelled event
3. A page similar to this should pop up
4. Under name you must enter (trip-day/time/destination) for example (trip-Tuesday/8:40/castle towers)
5. Then in details type in date-/-/-

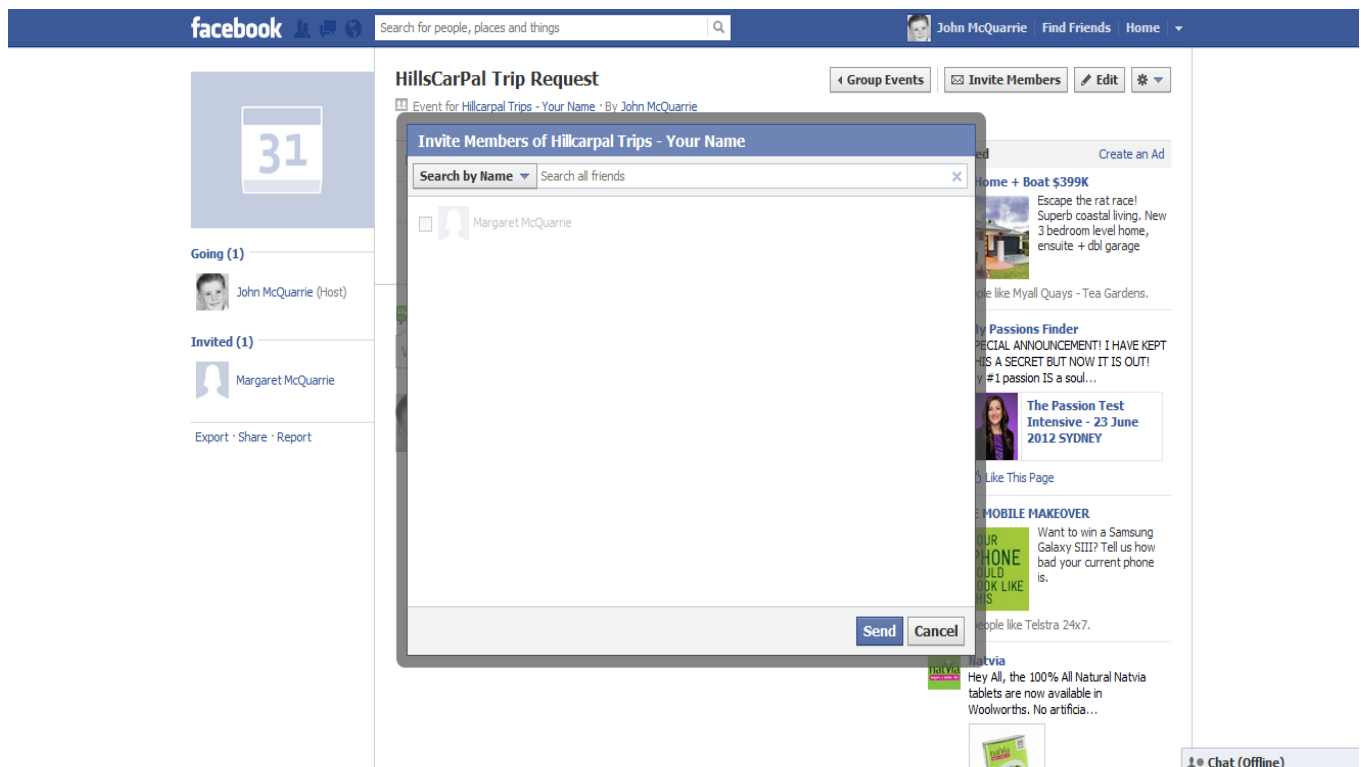

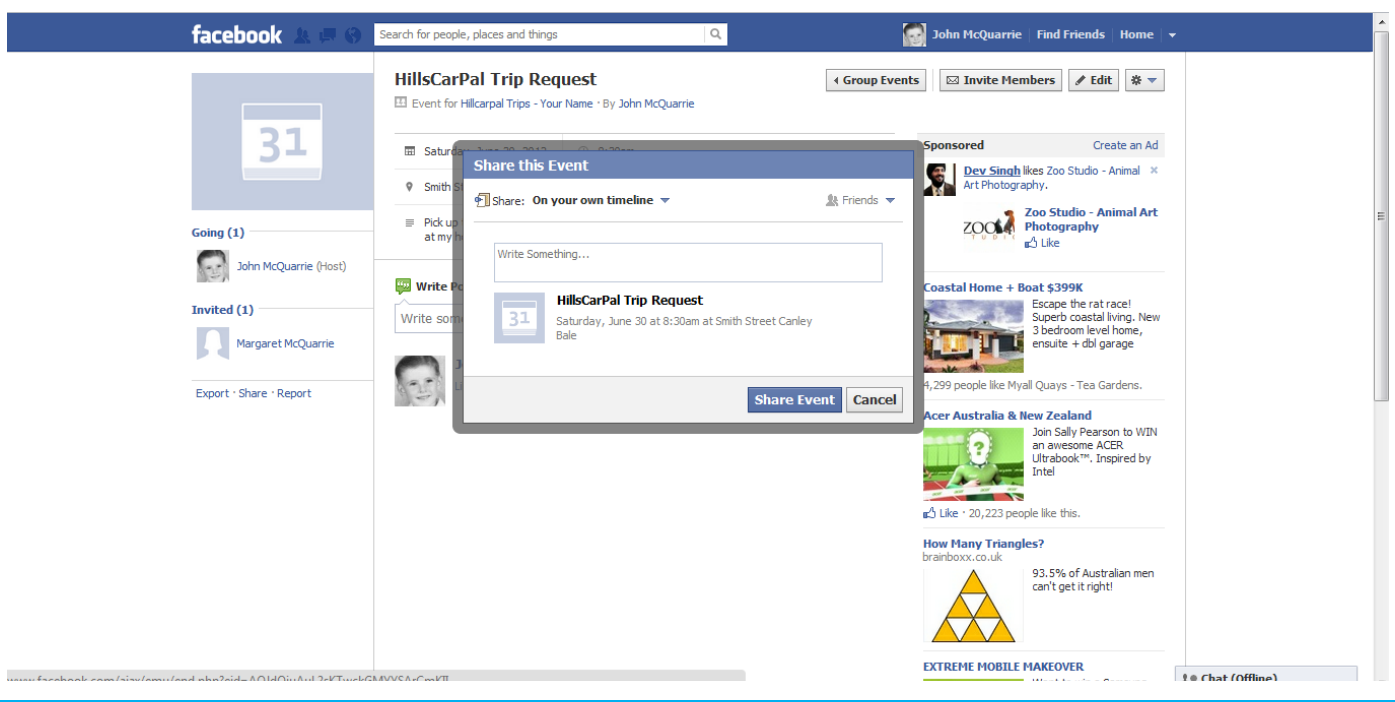
6. And then the address of the destination

8. You can check for updates on your event via your home page/newsfeed


9. Once You have Done Creating a event you will be able to invite people to this group to get it populated and chat with your mates on the event.



Once Someone Has Been Added Or Approved Joining the group you will be able to share it on your timeline to show who your friends with you went to this event and support it




Also If You Really need to remember when it is on you can optionally Export it to a calendar or email program such as Microsoft Outlook



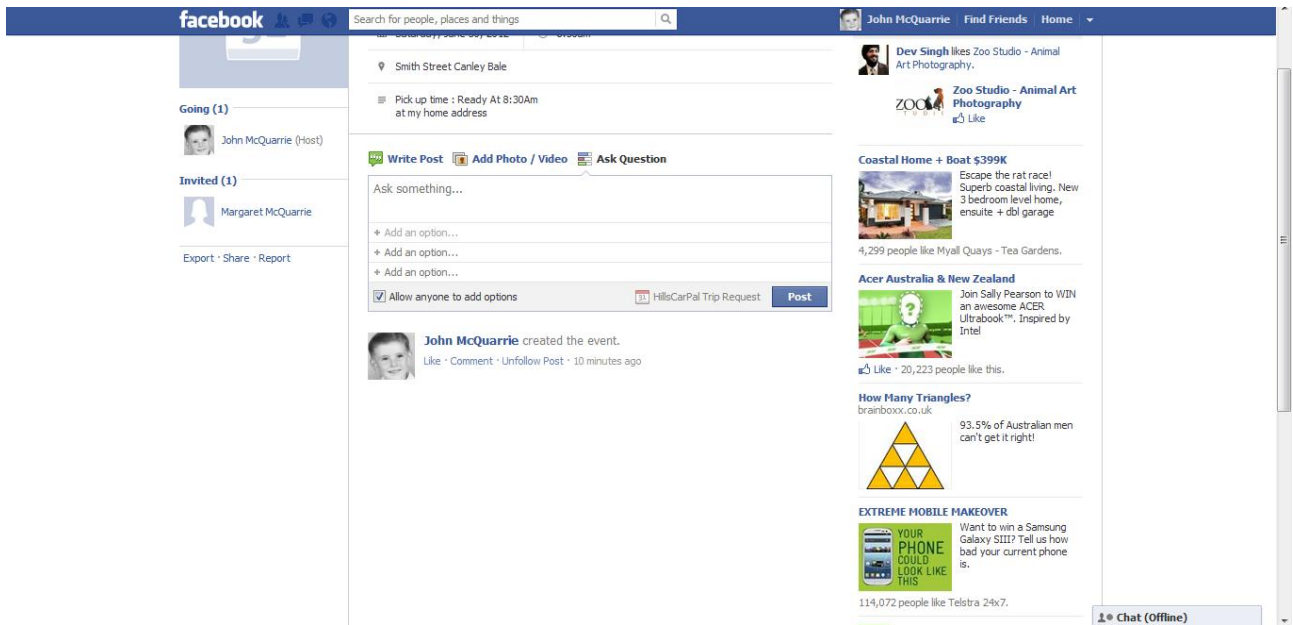
